

Guidelines for serving on the Executive Board of Directors of the Outdoor Recreation Council of British Columbia

Preferred background

- Currently active with an outdoor recreation organization.
- Has experience with more than one category of outdoor recreation.
- Has a strong interest in outdoor recreation and public policy issues such as access to crown lands, trails, and the well-being of the outdoor recreation community.
- Previous experience in the administration of non-government organizations (NGOs) is desirable.
- Has a willingness to bring forward issues of general concern to the outdoor recreation sector to meetings of the Executive.
- Has an ability to bring the perspective of the organization which nominated the candidate to the Executive meetings while bearing in mind that he or she is there to represent the entire outdoor recreation sector.
- Has an ability to take a balanced view of issues affecting the outdoor recreation sector.

Availability considerations

- Willing to usually be available in person or by phone for the monthly meetings which are generally at 5 PM on the first Monday of the month, except for holiday Mondays when they get shifted to the second Monday.
- Available to attend the Annual General Meeting, generally held on a Saturday in June, usually in the Lower Mainland.
