RE: Large-scale gravel extraction on the Vedder River.

Dear Ministers Heyman and Ralson,

The Outdoor Recreation Council of BC wishes to voice its concerns about the scale and extent of the MCSS gravel removal project that is proposed this summer for the Vedder River, Chilliwack. This commercial sediment removal project is unprecedented in scale and carries a significant risk of damage to pink salmon rearing habitat, along with the potential for massive erosion of the stream bed and large-scale sediment movement.

We believe that unless there's clear scientific evidence to the contrary, an appropriate precautionary approach to caring for the river and its fish stocks would dictate not proceeding with such a removal during a pink salmon year.
